Prepare your application

Group details

You can apply for the grant by completing this [application form](#). The form will ask you to provide information including contact details, where your group is located, links to social media pages and where you hope to carry out your project.

Project details

You will be asked to provide details on the activities you plan to undertake as part of your project and what you hope to achieve with the equipment you request. This information will be key for us in deciding whether your application is successful, so please spend some time on this.

Evidence

You'll be asked for proof of your group's eligibility by providing us with a copy of your signed constitution (if your group is constituted) or sharing with us other information to demonstrate your group's previous activity such as social media posts, videos, or local news articles.

Permissions

Landowner permission will be required for your activity if you are making changes to the land or the environment using tools or management practices. Should your application be successful, you will be asked to provide written proof of this. If you need advice on how to do this, please get in touch.

Landowner permission is not required for litter picking activities.

For applications with large changes to the land or environment, you will also need to demonstrate that you are covered by public liability insurance. Should your application be successful you will be asked for proof of this.

2. Download a copy of the "Equipment request spreadsheet" from our website and enter the quantity of tools that you require.
3. Send your completed spreadsheet to LYNengland@walkwheelcycletrust.org.uk with the subject heading in the following format: *Examplegroup - Equipment request*
4. Complete and submit the [application form](#) and wait to be contacted with a decision on whether your application is successful (within 3 weeks).
5. Should we wish to progress your application, we'll contact you to arrange a time/date to discuss your application.
6. Should you be successful, we'll send you an offer letter. Please sign and return this along with your group's signed constitution or other evidence and landowner permissions and public liability insurance certificate where appropriate
